Business Enabling Environment (BEE):


- promoting regulatory reform and best practice

EU4Business supports an eco-resort in the Ukrainian Carpathians

EU4Business and EBRD helped the TAOR Karpaty Resort & Spa complex develop an automated accounting and reporting system to better manage visitor preferences. After the project, the company increased the number of guests from 15,000 in 2018 to 27,000 in 2019.

a 2-year leasing agreement.

Two years ago, sewing company Santa Ukraina received support from EU4Business and the EBRD with local expert advice regarding CAD technology, allowing them to more rapidly and precisely manufacture garments.
